

UCSD TIES Digital Nursing Program Update

Students from the UCSD TIES Program held their Winter Quarter Update for St. Paul's John A McColl Family Health Center Staff on Thursday December 8th 2005.

The UCSD TIES Digital Nursing project has created a digital system that will allow the nurses at St. Paul's John A McColl Family Health Center and St. Paul's Villa (St. Paul's Assisted Living Community) to create electronic logs of each shift's logs.

These logs can be accessed by multiple nurses simultaneously; a feature that is not available on the original paper charts. The immediacy of access to this data creates a higher level of care and improves response time and accuracy.

During the presentation, the students expressed how the Program has allowed them to practically apply knowledge gained in the classroom to the real world. The inter-disciplinary nature of the program was also a great benefit for them, as the St. Paul's TIES program allowed students from different disciplines to work together on a real project.
